

SECTION 7 – CONTRA-INDICATIONS

7.1 ULTIMATE CONTRA-INDICATIONS

ABSOLUTE: Never or pending GP approval/disapproval
PARTIAL: Avoid treatment applications on concerned area(s)

<u>Body part/ parts affected</u>	Contra-indication: Absolute OR Partial	Explanation:
Face & Body	Pacemaker -Absolute	NEVER TREAT – micro-current could disturb heart rate and liability insurance will not cover.
Face & Body	Pregnancy and breast feeding - Absolute	Do not treat if halfway through course. – Reassure client and stop course immediately. Body treatments – After pregnancy wait 3-6 months after birth with a caesarean section. 3 –6 weeks after normal birth. Face treatments – as soon as client feels ready
Face & Body	All forms of cancer - Absolute	Retrieve a GP note for 5 years clear or in remission – But never if on chemotherapy or radiotherapy.
Face & Body	Epilepsy - Absolute	NEVER TREAT - micro-current may cause a seizure.
Face & Body	Heart conditions – Absolute	Retrieve a GP note. ie: Angina/ coronary heart disease
Face & Body	Diabetes - Partial Side effects of diabetes include Lack of skin sensation →	Ok if diet controlled – If insulin dependent retrieve a GP note. Perform tactile test – hot & cold / sharp & blunt.
Face & Body	Inflammation/ infections - Partial	Avoid area
Face & Body	Tumours - Absolute	Retrieve GP note.
Body	Varicose veins - Partial	Avoid area
Body	Body operation/ recent scar tissue - Partial	Wait 3-6 months depending on severity of operation.
Face	Facial operation/ recent scar tissue - Partial	Wait 3 months. NB: If body has undergone surgery the non-surgical face-lift treatment can still be administered & visa versa.
Face	Semi-Permanent Make-Up – Absolute for Microdermabrasion	Make-up colour will fade
Face & Body	Allergy to rubber/metal/ silicone - Absolute	Double probes are stainless steel. Body and facial pads are rubber based coated in silicone.
Face & Body	Thrombosis/ Phlebitis – Absolute	NEVER TREAT – micro-current could disturb/cause blood clotting.
Face & Body	Retin A (oral medication for acne) – Absolute	If prescribed by GP wait 3-6 months after completion of Retin A course depending on the medication dosage.
Face & Body	Roaccutane (oral medication for the treatment of severe acne) - Absolute	Wait 12-18 months after completion of roaccutane course depending on medication dosage.
Face & Body	Metal implants/ screws - Partial	Avoid area

For any other medication or medical condition not listed above, please advise clients to retrieve a GP note before performing any micro-current treatment.

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Face & Body	Prosthesis/silicone implants - Partial	Avoid area
Face & Body	High blood pressure - Partial	If taking medication for hypertension, then do not perform any face/ body treatments as such medications contradict the purpose of the treatment as they contain muscle relaxants.
Face & Body	Skin diseases - Partial	Avoid area due to risk of cross-contamination.
Face & Body	Multiple sclerosis - Absolute	NEVER – facial & body muscles will not respond
Face & Body	Severe muscular conditions - Absolute	Retrieve GP note. i.e. muscular dystrophy
Face & Body	Asthma – Partial for Microdermabrasion	Dust collected from dead skin could instigate an attack – advise client to bring an inhaler
Face	Botox - Partial	Avoid the area where botox has been injected, as the nerve response from muscle to the brain has been paralysed. Botox may also be dispersed if current is applied over it.
Face	Collagen/ fillers - Partial	For 2 weeks after injection avoid area where it has been injected due to discomfort. After 2 weeks continue full-face treatment.
Face & Body	Anti-depressants - Absolute	Most antidepressants contain a muscle relaxant. Contradicts purpose of treatment. Prozac medication does not contain a muscle relaxant so face & body treatments can be performed.
Face & Body	Over active thyroid - Absolute	Retrieve GP note
Body	The contraceptive coil - Partial	Most coils are now plastic. Ask client if metal based. If so, do not perform body treatments.
